We've recently hired a new Head of School, Dr. Anthony Sciubba, who shares the board's dream of creating a distinctly alpine flavor of classical Christian education (in a K-12 school) that perfectly complements its community, with designs to create a broader intellectual nexus for adults drawn to this lovely mountain town whether as visitors or residents for all four seasons of the year.

Telos is also a missional school called to welcome diverse families and students as we pursue a classical liberal arts education rooted in the tenets of traditional Christianity to form students who love truth, goodness, and beauty. Teachers at Telos are part of a collaborative culture of mentorship and ongoing formation in classical Christian education. We seek Christian educators who affirm the Nicene Creed and view teaching not merely as information transfer, but as the formation of the whole person.

Salt Lake City is just a 20-minute drive down the mountain valley (via I-80), with the SLC International Airport being just another 10 minutes.
